

# Latin Easter Holiday Work 2015

## Westminster Challenge : 8S

For revision you need your :

- **Latin Vocabulary and Dictionary booklet (= LVD)**
- **Additional Vocabulary for Scholarship booklet (= AVS)**
- **Latin Exercises Book 4**

Make sure you know your vocabulary and grammar 100% perfectly.

If you have access to a computer, try using *Onomata*, *Latin Verb / Noun Master*, *Opta*, *Match Up*, and *PMP Latin Grammar* to practise with; suitable settings are given on p.49 of *Latin Exercises Book 4*.

### Material to Revise

**Vocabulary** : **Vocabs 1-16** (in *LVD*)  
**Additional Vocabs 17-25** (or more if time) (in *AVS*)  
All **Principal Parts** on pp. 18-19 of *LVD*.  
**Comparison of Adjectives** on p.16 of *LVD*.

**Grammar** : All grammar on **pp. i-viii, 46** of *Latin Exercises Book 4*.  
For regular Verbs, concentrate on the Indicative tenses of *porto* and *mitto*, Active and Passive.  
For irregular Verbs, concentrate on the Present, Future, and Imperfect tenses.  
For Nouns and Adjectives, learn both the endings themselves and the uses of the cases on p.46.  
Also learn the irregular comparative and superlative adjectives and adverbs on p.viii.  
For Pronouns, concentrate on the notes on p.46.

**Syntax** : Use the notes in *Latin Exercises Book 4*.

The most important sections are :-

- **Time and Place Expressions** and Ablatives on p.2
- Active and **Passive** on pp. 6, 8
- **Relative Clause** on p.4
- **Participles** and **Ablative Absolute** on pp. 12, 14, 20
- **Indirect Statement** on p.22
- **Indirect Command** and **Indirect Question** on pp. 16, 24
- **Other uses of the Subjunctive** on pp. 16, 18, 24

Also check over **English to Latin Sentences** on p.41.

Try the two practice papers I've provided and then self-assess your version using my answer sheets.

Also, for specific syntactical topics, use the booklet of practice questions and again use the answers provided to check your knowledge.
