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Message from the Head Teacher

Thank you to everyone who completed the parent questionnaire for us last half term. We had 33 responses in total. This is the highest response to surveys over the last 2 years, so although I would have liked more responses, this level of response is positive for the school. There was a very obvious pattern within responses from parents across all year groups regarding regularity and type information we are sharing with parents about children's progress. attainment and next steps. Currently there are 3 written reports a year, 2 of which tie in with parents evening. In school, discussing possibly are changing this system to one where we report back half termly to parents about children's targets and their progress towards them so you are kept more regularly updated on progress in specific areas and also have a clearer picture of how you can support vour children at home. From the

report at the end of this term, parents will also start receiving summative assessment mation against National expectations for their children, i.e. whether they are emerging into age related expectations, achieving age related expectations exceeding age related expectations. The age related expectation for the end of the Summer term for your child is detailed on the curriculum information that has come home to you this half term. These are the standards that the teachers have been assessing your children against all term, and the ones they will report against in the reports.

Your feedback is very important to us, and helps us to shape our School Improvement Priorities moving forward. We are a school that wants to continually develop and improve and knowing how parents would like to see us improve is key to that.
