Over the summer months, we carried out a number of refurbishment works to ICT 2, Peterborough Hall, various toilets etc. We also completed Phase 2 of the Car Park and improved the security around the perimeter of the site in the form of new fencing and controlled gates. We are always looking to balance an inviting campus with a secure site and hope that the new systems become quickly embedded. I am aware that the surrounding traffic has been dreadful on the Epsom side due to the number of roadworks. To assist with the Car Park flow in the mornings, the following guidance will ensure that everyone uses the Car Park safely and sensibly.

If you plan to get out of your car when dropping off your child, please drive to the Lower Car Park and park, walking in front of the Sports Hall entrance to the Turret;

If you plan to drop your child off without going into school yourself, please drive to the drop zone at the front of the school and allow your child to make their way along the pedestrian walkway to the crossing before entering at the Turret;

If the drop zone is full, please drive clockwise to the A24 side of the car park, where there remain a number of spaces, and allow your child to walk along the pedestrian walkway and into school. With Phase 2 complete, there are also likely to be spaces available along the one-way system towards the exit

For those new parents, a little additional information about this activity: the Saturday morning 'Sports Club' is run by Downsend staff at Main Site, as a method of proving additional sports coaching to all those girls and boys who are keen to participate. This club is solely for Downsend pupils at no expense and will continue to operate as a drop-in service; if you wish your child to attend, simply turn up. The club will run every Saturday (finishing on 9 December 2017) excluding the following dates:

- 21 October (Half Term)
- 28 October (Half Term)
- 4 November (Half Term)
- 25 November (DPA Xmas Fair)

The aim is to create a fun environment where pupils can develop an enthusiasm for sport, whilst playing with their school friends. The majority of the training is held on the main Astroturf next to the car park, although occasionally on the grass pitches or within the Sports Hall, depending on the weather and other school matches. Throughout the year a variety of sports will be introduced, all aimed at improving the fundamentals of balance, spatial awareness, co-ordination, speed, agility and most importantly fun! We ask that all pupils wear their Downsend sports clothing (shin pads for footballers), trainers and bring a water bottle.

Similarly to last year, refreshments can now be purchased from within the new Sports Pavilion.


We were delighted by the response last year and can already see the benefits that this ground work has generated within our sports teams; we look forward to seeing you this Saturday 9 September.
