Message from the Head Teacher

It has been an exciting week for Downsend school this week. On Wednesday Mr Thorpe announced the expansion of Downsend from 2020 to include a GCSE programme enabling children to stay at Downsend until the age of 16. He explained the addition of a new creative arts centre at the main site and also the refurbishment of the Treganna building to support the expansion project. Mr Thorpe also announced that from 2020, the 3 Pre-Preps would welcome their first Year 2 cohort (the current Rising Reception children), with the transition to main site changing from the end of Year 1 to the end of Year 2. I think this is a huge positive for our school. I look forward to having a full Key

Stage 1 cohort in school and the flexibility that will give us around the curriculum for both Year 1 and Year 2. Planning for the addition of a year group at Pre-Prep Epsom is in its infancy and I have 3 meetings next week where plans will be discussed. As soon as I know more about any building development plans, numbers of classes or the bigger picture of where we will be housing Year 2 I will let you know.
