Swimming



The swimming trials at the start of the term gave an encouraging insight into what lay ahead for the boys' swimming team. The first match of term, after only two weeks, was a co-ed U9-U11 gala against Feltonfleet. The boys played their part in a significant opening win of the term. A week later Downsend took on CLFS and the squad showed their depth of talent and ability with another comprehensive win. Another week further on and the team were engaged in a real contest with Danes Hill. This was a 'neck and neck' event with each school taking the lead on four separate occasions through the course of the match. The freestyle relays in the closing stages of the gala were to be some of the best swimming of the evening and Downsend pulled away to take the win.

A month later, following half term, the match against Cranmore was to be highlight of the sporting season. A poor start to the match, with some weak finishes in the backstroke section saw Cranmore take an early lead. This was compounded further with slow starts by Downsend and strong freestyle and breaststroke by Cranmore. With 14 events to go Downsend were 18 points behind and a win looked to be a distant hope however...... A number of Downsend swimmers won their races and the Downsend 'B' swimmer then took a third and sometimes even a second place which saw the team chipping away at the Cranmore lead. The freestyle relays were once again to be the key to success and in the final event with the results all square, the Under 13 A and B boys took the points for a dramatic win.

The final event of the term was against KCS Junior School. With a number of excellent swims from both schools, the Downsend boys tipped the balance once again showing their strength to win and ending the term as an unbeaten team. Well done everybody!
