Cybercrime Warning - School Fees

I would like to take this opportunity to remind all parents to be extremely vigilant when paying monies to the school. This is in light of a recent spate of phishing attacks targeting independent school parents in connection with the payment of fees, as reported by the Independent Schools Council and the media here.

Please beware of phishing emails in relation to fees and check the bank details you are using for your payments are correct. We have not changed our bank account details, have no plans to do so and would only ever communicate such a change to you formally — not in an email at the point of invoicing for payment.

Fraudulent emails can appear official. If at any time you receive anything you feel is suspicious, please email or telephone the school directly on the usual telephone number/address, not one contained within the email. Paying fees by Direct Debit will also significantly reduce the risk of fraud.

Meanwhile we are continuing to ensure our own cyber security given these cases in other schools. Thank you in advance for taking extra care so we can all remain vigilant to fraud.
