#### Keeping Children Safe

Over the next few weeks there will be a different focus in the weekly newsletter related to our Child Protection systems and processes in school

#### This week: what do we if a child makes an allegation?

If a child makes an allegation that they have been hit or hurt by someone, we are required to contact our MASH (Multi-Agency Safeguarding Hub) for advice. We are proud of the relationship we have with parents at Downsend Pre-Prep Epsom and would always prefer to talk to you first, but we have been told that we are not to do this until we have been advised to do so. From our experiences, when we call MASH there are different 2 courses of action that they could take. They may advise us to speak to you ourselves to gather more information before a decision is made or they may contact you directly. I do understand that being contacted by MASH (you will most likely be called by a social worker in the team) without any prior warning from us regarding concerns will be a huge surprise. Please be rest assured that we are following standard procedures and therefore we must take this course of action.

Our neighbours in Windmill Close have requested that we do not 'double park' on the road. There is currently building work going on at the end of the road and lorries and works vehicles have been unable to gain access to their site. Thank you for your support.
