Thank you to all the parents who have asked questions and shown an interest in our move towards becoming a storytelling school. I will continue to give more information and answer your guestions over the rest of this year. A question-how will a storytelling school meet the needs of both boys and girls? The storytelling skills and philosophy will permeate through all curriculum areas. It is essentially about strong communication skills, knowledge and confidence which meets the needs of all children. There will be a focus on the creative, imaginative side of storytelling as a means to support creative writing as the children are ready for this, but there will also be a very high focus on storytelling in terms of science, geography,
