Message from the Head Teacher

What a relief to be back to normal this week!

So, what does being a storytelling school mean? The storytelling approach is underpinned by 3 main elements: language and communication, a breadth and depth of knowledge (academic focus) and also confidence and resilience to talk in front of a range of audiences (character development focus). The storytellapproach will permeate through all the different areas of learning from the 'stories' that children need to give to technological items to get them to work, so early coding, all the way through to understanding and telling the stories that have inspired artists and composers to create the pieces of work that they have created. In maths the storytelling focus will be on children explaining, justifying and reasoning and in literacy it will be on retelling stories and making up stories of their own. Our first big move into becoming a storytelling school will begin in the Summer term when all staff will receive training on Talk4writing, a strategy to use as a basis for storytelling in the classroom. We will then to start to develop the strategies across the curriculum as described. As parents, you won't see huge changes in the school as a result of this focus. Storytelling is a 'hook' to bring our curriculum together so the changes you will see will be in our environment and curriculum planning as we start to reflect this approach, but more so in your children as their storytelling skills develop further.
