Danes Hill Girls Cricket Festival - Tuesday 8 May

As the girls got into the bowling a number of wickets fell assisting the score line, resulting in a first victory for Downsend.

Our second game of the afternoon was against the hosts – Danes Hill. Winning the toss we opted to field first. Our opening bowlers took 4 wickets and the run of wickets continued throughout the game. A total of 8 wickets were taken in the game and this put us into a good position as we went into bat. Our

opening batters scored well with a number of 6's! The rest of team continued the batting streak securing another win.

After a short rest we took to the field against Hoe Bridge. Despite some strong fielding from the opposition the girls batted well but would need to continue to field well to take the win. It was clear from the start of the innings that Hoe Bridge had some strong batters but the girls adjusted the field and started to take a few wickets assisting the score line. Despite a strong effort the girls were unable to secure the victory meaning we had to win the next game to be in with a chance of the overall win.

Our final game was against Rowan and having lost the toss had to bat first. Once again the girls batted extremely well securing our greatest number of runs of the tournament. As we headed into the field we knew that if we were to win the game we would be tied on points with Hoe Bridge. The winning team would then be decided on number of wickets taken throughout the afternoon. The girls took to the field with excitement and the wickets started to fall. A total of 10 wickets were taken in this game, with a number of superb catches. Having bowled and fielded so well, the victory was ours.

As we headed to the presentation we knew the result would be down to the wickets taken. Having taken a large number in the final game, resulting in 25 wickets taken throughout the afternoon the girls were crowned the overall winners.

It has been fantastic to see the development and interest of the girls as we are moving away from Rounders to Cricket and we look forward to further matches throughout the term.
