

## Reception, Year 1 & Year 2

For new parents and our Reception parents, a little additional information about this activity: the Saturday morning 'Sports Club' is run by Downsend staff at Main site, as a method of providing additional sports coaching to all those girls and boys who are keen to participate. This club is solely for Downsend pupils at no expense and will continue to operate as a drop-in service; if you wish your child to attend, simply turn up. The club will run every Saturday (finishing on 8 December) excluding the following dates:

The aim is to create a fun environment where pupils can develop an enthusiasm for sport, whilst playing with their school friends. The majority of the training is held on the main Astroturf next to the car park, although occasionally on the grass pitches or within the Sports Hall, depending on the weather and other school matches. Throughout the year a variety of sports will be introduced, all aimed at improving the fundamentals of balance, spatial awareness, co-ordination, speed, agility and most importantly fun! We ask that all pupils wear their Downsend sports clothing (shin pads for footballers), trainers and bring a water bottle.

Similarly to last year, refreshments can now be purchased from within the Sports Pavilion.

We were delighted by the response last year and can already see the benefits that this ground work has generated within our sports teams; we look forward to seeing you this Saturday 8 September.
