

#### Words of the Week

Next weeks words are creativity words and lead on from last weeks words about community and kindness.

In assembly yesterday I explained to the children that creativity is about using your imagination and having ideas and that to be creative you need to use your brain and think. We talked about everything we do starting with a thought in our head and what a powerful tool our brain is! We also talked about making sure we use our brain in the best way possible.

Think—thinking starts in your head. You might think about what you are going to do, what you are going to say, where you are going to go. Everything we do starts with us thinking.

Reflect—when we reflect, we are still thinking. We are thinking about something we have said or done after we have said or done it. We might reflect on whether we did the best thing or could have done something differently. We reflect on what we might do next.

Daydream—when we daydream we are thinking still. We are thinking about things we love doing or people we love. When we daydream we might not be thinking about the things we really should be thinking about!

Thoughtful—when you are thoughtful, it shows you are thinking of others. The children linked the word thoughtful to kindness as focused on this week for Anti-Bullying Week and as part of World Kindness Day.

Please ensure all children have coats and warm additional clothing such as hats etc as we will continue to go outside as much as possible as the weather gets colder. Please also ensure everything is clearly named.
