It has been wonderful to have the children back in school this week. It is lovely when the school is quiet, but better when is full of energy, chatter and play!

This half term our whole school topic is 'All About People' and we were very excited to welcome Elli Woollard, author and our Patron of Reading for 2019, to school this week to talk about what being an author is like but also to plan our work together over the year. We hope that our partnership with Elli will support us to continue to develop even further our focus and enthusiasm on reading, storytelling and writing. Elli was particularly impressed by the children's clear love of books and reading, their knowledge of the terminology author, poet and illustrator and that they knew all about how a library worked!

Another new initiative we are launching this year for Reception and Year 1 is called Pobble. The Pobble platform, a secure online

platform, will allow our children to publish their writing to a global Pobble audience making all of our children published authors! Many other Cognita schools are also Pobble members and so our children will be able to share their writing with other Reception and Year 1 children across the Cognita world giving and receiving feedback and also collecting ideas. We are hoping to publish our first pieces of work by half term.

With small numbers in the school it can be challenging to run a broad enrichment programme so we thank you for your support enabling us to do this.
