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Message from the Head Teacher

We started the week with Make your dreams come true day, ended with a safeguarding audit and had lots of excitement and activity in between. Clearly the highlight of the week was the few flakes of snow on Thursday morning though!

Our safeguarding visit today is an annual audit conducted by our proprietors, Cognita, to ensure we are meeting theirs and the Independent School Standards for safeguarding. In fact, Cognita's own standards are much higher than the Independent School Standards. This demonstrates the schools and Cognita's commitment to ensuring the safety and security of your children at all times. At the time of writing the newsletter the auditors have looked in depth at Safer Recruitment and personnel checks, site safety and security, admissions records for children in school and how we ensure children who leave to do not get 'losť' or iust disappear,

have interviewed a range of staff assess the safeguarding to culture in the school, looked at staff training, organisation for trips and visits. all of our safeguarding records and provision for medical needs and First Aid.....and it's not even lunchtime yet! The audit is very thorough, as it should be. When our report arrives, I will share the information with you.
