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Message from the Head Teacher

This week we welcomed James Carroll, our Cognita Director of Education, Mr Newland the Head of Upper School, Miss Ellis from Pre-Prep Leatherhead and Mrs Roberts and Mrs Hill from Pre-Prep Ashtead to our school as part of a Downsend wide School Improvement Activity. The purpose of the activity was to highlight shared strengths across the schools and to support us in writing a joint Improvement Plan for 19/20 by identifying shared priorities. We are still collating the final report but identified strengths include the expertise of teachers to develop children's language and communication skills, our approach to the teaching of maths in Y1, Talk for Writing and the quality of interactions by all adults to support children to make the best progress. Next steps are mostly related to continuing to consistency develop within systems across the 3 pre-preps and from the pre-preps into the prep. Overall the activity was a really positive one and the start of many more teaching and learning focused activities across the 3 pre-preps.
