Welcome back to a new term and a new decade! I thoroughly enjoyed being greeted by a sea of smiling children on Tuesday morning. Listening to everyone's stories, I can tell that a great deal of fun has been had by all over the Christmas break.

It was a year ago that we launched and integrated into the curriculum our STEAM approach to learning. The children are thriving on this problem solving and thinking based approach to their learning. Levels of confidence, perseverance and resilience have risen, along with academic achievement which we are delighted to see. To further support this approach and to start developing future learning

skills that our young children will need, we have moved forward with the CPA (concrete, pictorial, abstract) method of teaching mathematics. Based on a problem solving approach, independent mathematical thinking starts right from First Steps, carries on through our school and on to the Main School in Year Two. This term we will be inviting you to come along to a Maths Curriculum evening on Thursday 13 February. At this meeting you will be able to find out more about this approach to learning mathematical concepts and to view how it is delivered in each year group. Save the date!

We have also been following with interest, the way that Greta

Thunberg has been raising worldwide awareness about climate change and feel that it's important for our children to understand what they can do to help protect our planet. Our 'Eco Week', which is coming up at the end of January, will focus on 'Reduce, Reuse, Recycle'. As part of the week, we will be encouraging children and families to get involved with our projects.
