Each week we celebrate a special piece of work in our celebrations assembly.

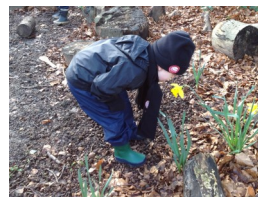
