The final work of the week this school year in Ladybirds class goes to everyone. They are all superstars and have worked really hard all year. Well done to you all.

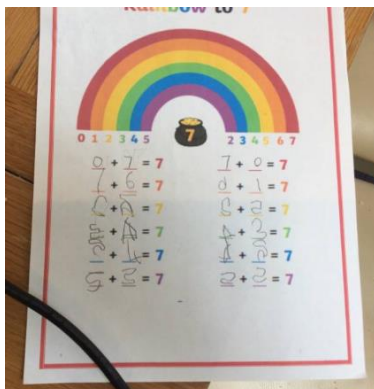


## Foxes
