THE DETAILS

WHAT CAN I BOOK FOR?



We have designed the service so that it covers as much of our catchment as possible, adding routes where we are able. We also have a station to school and school to station service. You are able to book a combination of services, priority will be given to those wanting to book both AM and PM services, but you may be able to book just AM or PM subject to availability.

SAFETY PROCEDURES

Our minibuses and drivers undergo rigorous safety checks.

- Extensive risk assessments are undertaken of each route
- Safeguarding regulations are adhered to at all times
- All external contractors undertake relevant safeguarding checks, and must provide insurance documents, and maintenance records.
- All drivers are correctly licensed and trained.
- Safety belts are in place, checked and required to be worn by all passengers
- All drivers have a mobile phone in the vehicle, this is to communicate any last minute changes by text. The driver will not answer the phone if it is called.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- You are expected to arrive at the bus stop at least 3 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.
- Bookings are made for the relevant term, if you wish to discontinue the service, we ask that you provide half a term (6 weeks) notice (or 6 weeks payment in lieu of notice). Transport fees are non-refundable.
- The timetable is set to take into account average traffic conditions for the time of day the service runs. There may be some circumstances out of the drivers or schools control that may result in a late arrival of the bus. We will therefore be able to vary the bus route when required but will communicate this to anyone affected.
- Drivers are instructed to leave on time to ensure other students arrive at school on time.
- By completing the booking form, you consent to settling your transport costs (as detailed in this brochure) via Cognita Connect

COST



FULL TIME SERVICE (MORNINGS AND EVENINGS)

We ask you to book your child's seat for 5 mornings and 5 evenings per week:

• Termly cost: £470

MORNING OR EVENING SERVICE (ROUTES 1-8)

We ask you to book your child's seat for either 5 mornings or 5 evenings per week:

- Termly cost per route: £235
- Ashtead Village (Route 1 stop 8) there is a nominal charge of £5 per week to secure a seat on this service.

MORNING STATION TO SCHOOL SERVICE

The Morning Station Service is offered free of charge <u>for those who travel by train</u> to local stations. This applies to:

- Ashtead Train Station pick up
- Route 2 Leatherhead Train Station pick up (bus stop 5)

You are still required to book this service and notify us if your child will not be using it so we are able to adhere to safeguarding rules in relation to your child's whereabouts. If you wish to use the service, and you do not get the train, there is a nominal charge of £5 per week to secure a seat on the service.

AFTERNOON/EVENING SCHOOL TO STATION SERVICE

The Evening Station Service is offered free of charge <u>for those who travel by train</u> from local stations. This applies to:

• Ashtead Train Station drop off

You are still required to book this service and notify us if your child will not be using it so we are able to adhere to safeguarding rules in relation to your child's whereabouts. If you wish to use the service, and you do not get the train, there is a nominal charge of £5 per week to secure a seat on the service.

Once booked and confirmed, you will be asked to pay your balance via Cognita Connect.

THE DETAILS

USING CLUBS, SPORTS PRACTICES, EXTENDED DAY OR SUPERVISED STUDY BEFORE A 17:40PM DEPARTURE



If you select an Evening Route that departs at 17:40, our assumption is that your child will be attending an after-school club, a sports practice or Extended Day/Supervised Study. You will need to book these options for your child when the booking form is launched but there is no charge for Extended Day/Supervised Study on days that school transport is used.

New Friday 5pm departure

In response to parental feedback we are making a change to Friday bus departure times. On a Friday all PM buses (except the school to Ashtead station bus) will depart at the new time of 5pm. We will publish the bus stop arrival over the summer holidays for routes affected.

NOTIFYING US OF YOUR CHILD'S ABSENCE

We take our safeguarding responsibility seriously, so we need you to communicate with us when your child is not expected to be using the service. This saves us a great deal of time as we have to look for pupils on site, if they do not arrive on the bus. This is also a great inconvenience to staff and pupils on the service as it impacts on departure and drop off times.

We ask you to:

- Please notify us by the preceding Sunday of any changes for that week via Cognita Connect messages. Type 'Transport' into the 'To' box. This will send a message to our Transport Coordinator and the Office Team.
- For any last minute emergency changes please follow the same procedure but also text the driver to let them know not to wait.

Our expectation is that your child will be on the minibus unless you inform us otherwise.
