Wrap-around care



To assist with our staffing and safeguarding, we ask that you book your child's wrap-around care for the whole term.

Charges will be added to your account on Cognita Connect on a half termly basis, based on when your child attends as opposed to what you book.

All wrap-around care will commence from Wednesday 23rd April 2025.

Early Birds and Breakfast 7:30am - 8am £7.50 Held in the Dining Hall, where the catering team will be offering healthy breakfast items from 50p (cash only please).

Junior Prep - Y3 to Y6 After school until 4:20pm No charge Children will do their homework or read quietly from when their school day finishes until 4:20pm

There is no prep on the last day of term due to the school closing earlier than the usual departure time.

If your child is attending a club that starts later than the end of the school day, your child will automatically attend prep. Please only sign up for prep if this is the only requirement.

Extended Day Until 5:45pm £15 Sandwiches and fruit platters are available and included in the price.

Please note that if you collect after 5:45pm, there will be a late charge issued to your account for each occasion.

There is no Extended Day on the last day of term due to the school closing earlier than the usual departure time.

Emergency Ad-hoc

We do understand that there are occasions when booking in advance is not possible.

In the event that you need to book your child for Prep or Extended Day on the day, please complete the 'JS End of Day Arrangements' Form on Cognita Connect by 1pm or call the reception team.

Clubs

After seeking feedback from the children, we have reviewed our club programme and are delighted to offer some new clubs such as Yoga, Drama, Karaoke and Dance as well as favourites which they continually request. In addition, Summer Term sees the return of Rounders, Athletics, Y5 and Y6 Lego and Y3 and Y4 Art with Mrs Corr. We have continued to work on providing a range of clubs for each year group throughout the week.

In the Summer Term, Cricket fixtures can often mean a later return due to the nature of the sport, so we have been mindful of this when planning the Summer Programme.

The final week of term includes Sports Days and Prizegiving so clubs cannot be offered. However, for parents who need childcare, please be reassured that we will offer an after school provision for children who usually attend a club and need to stay in school.

- Clubs will run from Wednesday 23rd April until Friday 4th July 2025.
- Prep and Extended Day will continue until Tuesday 8th July 2025. Early Birds will continue until Wednesday 9th July 2025.
- To assist with sibling collection, for those parents who who have siblings coming out of clubs at different times, we are happy to offer Extended Day to fill the short gap (around 20 minutes) at no extra cost. Once the clubs have been confirmed, you will have the opportunity to book this provision.
- Charges will be added to your account on Cognita Connect at half term for clubs that are run by Downsend Staff.
- If a club is externally run, you will be sent further details about how to make payment. Payment must be made in advance to secure your space. By signing up for a place at an externally run club, you give permission for your contact details to be passed on to the external club provider.




